ADMISSION/COUNSELING- B.SC. NURSING (2019)

All the candidates who have applied for B.Sc. Nursing Course in affiliated colleges are required to appear for Counseling in order of merit-cum-preference for admission to B.Sc. Nursing programme for the session 2019-20, at Brig. Rajinder Singh Auditorium, University of Jammu, Jammu, as per the following schedule. The Candidates are requested to deposit the fee as per detail given below in the form of Demand Draft/s drawn in favour of Director, Colleges Development Council, University of Jammu.

(i) For Govt. College: Rs.50,000/- per annum for Non-Priority Household (NPHH) Category)

(ii) Rs. 30,000/- per annum for Priority Household (PHH) Category

Admission fee (one time) Rs. 20,000/-

(ii) For Non-Govt. Colleges: Rs. 75,000/- per annum

BREAK-UP OF THE RESERVED CATEGORIES FOR GOVERNMENT COLLEGES ONLY:

- Schedule Caste 8%
- ALC 2%
- ST (Gujjar, Bakerwals, Gaddies, Baltis, Sippi) 5%
- ST (Residence of Districts of Leh & Kargil) 2%
- Candidates belonging to Backward area other than that of districts Leh & Kargil. 2%
- #Economically Weaker Sections among General Category.- Supernumerary seats 10%
- ##Candidates with disabilities (Orthopedically Handicapped and Blind Candidates)-Supernumerary seats 3%

(Supernumerary seats are non-convertible)

- (i) # Admission under this category i.e. Economically Weaker Section (EWSs) of society, are only for those

who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the SC, ST, socially and Economically Backward Classes etc. The reservation would be in addition to the existing reservations and subject to a maximum of 10% of the prescribed intake capacity. These seats (EWSs) shall be non-convertible i.e. if the seat/s under this category remain vacant, it shall not be converted to Open or any other category. The definition of economically weaker sections shall be such as notified by the Government and candidates shall submit the requisite certificate issued by the Competent Authority.

- (ii) **##** Candidate suffering a degree of disability of 40% and above and visually impaired candidates are eligible for admission. Certificate of an Orthopedic Handicapped or visually impaired shall be considered only if it is issued by the Head of the Department of Orthopedic or that of Ophthalmology of a Government Medical College/District Hospital. The Vice-Chancellor, if so desires, may seek advice in the matter, of a committee to be appointed by him.

The counselling shall be conducted in two shifts i.e. from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM (1st shift) and 2:00 PM to 5:00 PM (2nd Shift) as per detail given below at Brig. Rajender Singh auditorium, University of Jammu.

Vacant seats in reserved category (if any) shall be converted to open seats.

- Merit-wise list of candidates shall be displayed on the University Websites i.e. jucdc.in, jammuuniversity.in and the notice board of the Auditorium.
- Candidates failing to appear personally in the counseling shall forfeit their claim for admission. However, the claim of such candidate may be considered against vacant seats, if any, at the time of reporting by such a candidate.
- No candidate shall be allowed to participate in counseling without requisite fee, downloaded application form and original documents.

- For any discrepancy in admission/merit, the decision of the admission committee constituted for the purpose shall be final and binding.
- Candidates applying under PHH category shall submit the certificate from the Competent Authority.
- No certificate, that is under process, shall be considered for admission

The following documents in original are required for verification at the time of counseling.

- Higher Secondary/Senior Secondary School certificate/marks sheet
- Category Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
- Demand Draft/s favouring Director, Colleges Development Council, University of Jammu, amounting to:
